If older brother Chayan could wave a magic wand and become anything he desires, he would be superstar in the NBA (like Magic Johnson). Without the wand, Chayan plans to go to college and hone in on career options then. Tivo, on the other hand, is inspired by how his older brother is protective and therefore Tivo wants to be a police officer when he grows up so he can take his turn at helping and protecting others.
