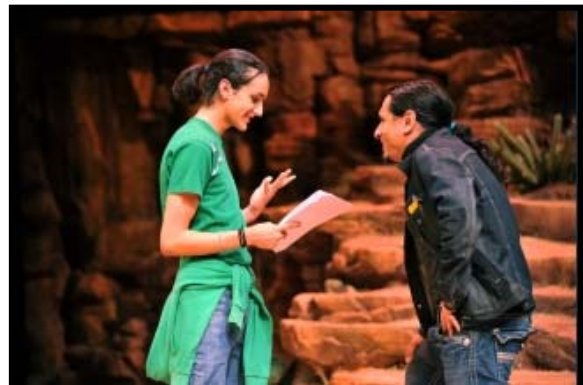

Apropos for someone aspiring to be an actor, Kyle is an expressive teen. So we'll let Kyle take it from here in his own words...

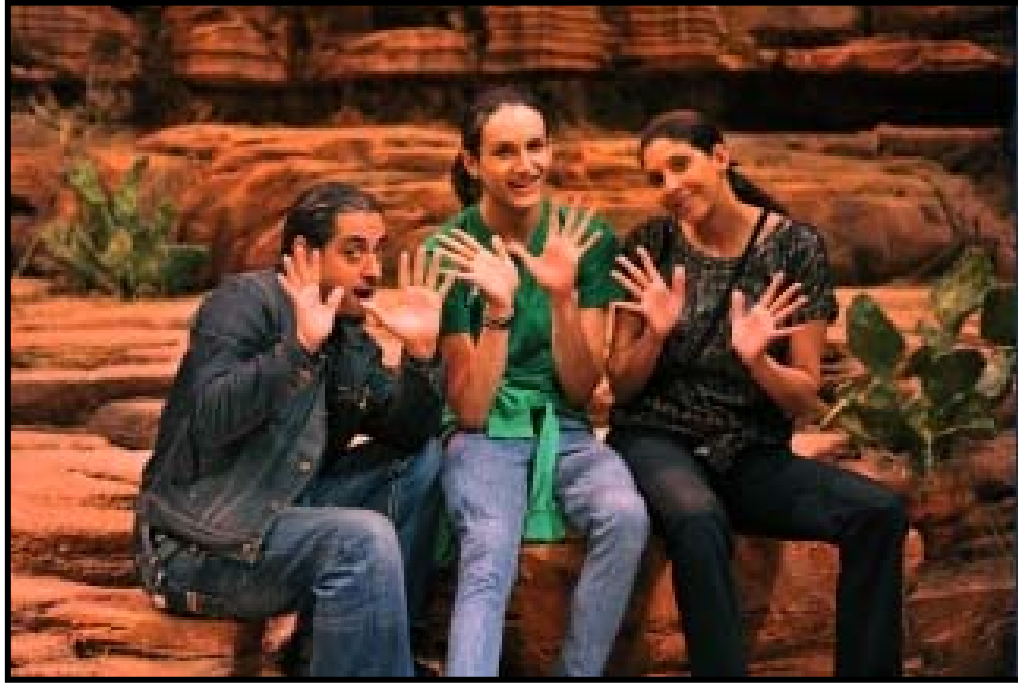
