

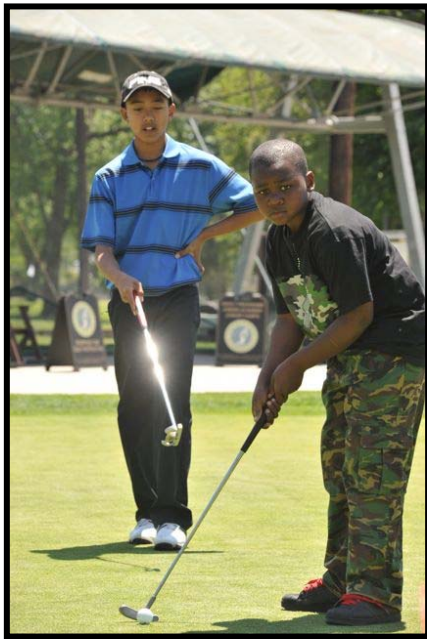

Wednesday's Child



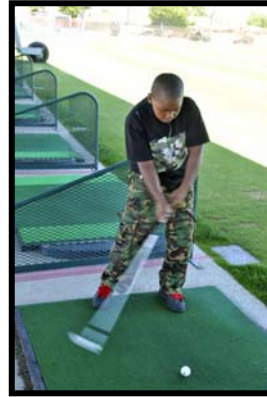
