2. Recommendation as submitted by Supervisors Solis and Kuehl: Designate October 12th of each year, as “Italian American Heritage Day” in the County of Los Angeles, to recognize the contributions of Italian Americans to the history and culture of Los Angeles; create “Indigenous Peoples Day” as an official County holiday to be observed on the second Monday of each October and to be recognized no later than the 2019 calendar year; direct County Counsel to create an ordinance to remove all references to “Columbus Day” as an official County holiday and recognize “Indigenous Peoples Day” instead; instruct all Department Heads, upon passage of the ordinance, to include recognition and observance of “Indigenous Peoples Day” on all relevant County documents including, but not limited to, calendars, schedules and administrative materials; and send a five-signature letter to the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education (LAUSD Board) subsequent to official Board action, indicating that the County will now recognize “Indigenous Peoples Day” on the second Monday of each October and urge the LAUSD Board to consider taking a similar action.
