- 13.** Recommendation as submitted by Supervisor Knabe: Proclaim October 2014 as “Quality and Productivity Month” throughout Los Angeles County in recognition of County employees’ efforts to enhance productivity and improve the quality of County services; and take the following related actions:

Request the Music Center to waive the \$750 use fee at the Grand Hall and Lobby of the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for the 28th Annual Productivity and Quality Awards Program, to be held October 22, 2014;

Waive the \$6,000 parking fees for approximately 300 vehicles at the Music Center Garage, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for attendees of the event;

Direct the Chief Executive Officer and the Director of Internal Services to provide the necessary support services for activities related to the “Quality and Productivity Month” celebrations, including the luncheon;

Direct the Executive Officer of the Board to schedule the annual presentation of the Productivity and Quality Awards Top 10 winners for the Board meeting of October 28, 2014; and

Waive the \$800 parking fees for approximately 40 vehicles at the Music Center Garage, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for the Productivity and Quality awardees attending the October 28, 2014 Board ceremony. (14-4123)
